PRIVACY POLICY

Effective Date: March 12, 2017

The following Privacy Policy governs the online information collection practices of DUNN PELLIER MEDIA and DUNNPELLIERMEDIA.COM (“we” or “us”).

This Privacy Policy provides our policies and procedures for collecting, using, and disclosing your information. Users can access the dunnpelliermedia.com website (the “Website”) and the services related thereto (the “Services”) through the URL dunnpelliermedia.com. This Privacy Policy governs your access of the Website, regardless of how you access it, and by using our Services you consent to the collection, transfer, processing, storage, disclosure and other uses described in this Privacy Policy. All of the different forms of data, content, and information described below are collectively referred to as “information.”

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. By visiting and using the Site, you agree that your use of our Site, and any dispute over privacy, is governed by this Privacy Policy. Because the Web is an evolving medium, we may need to change our Privacy Policy at some point in the future, in which case we’ll post the changes to this Privacy Policy on this website and update the Effective Date of the policy to reflect the date of the changes. By continuing to use the Site after we post any such changes, you accept the Privacy Policy as modified.

The Information We Collect And Store

We may collect and store the following information with the Website or Services:

Information You Provide. When you create an account, we collect some personal information, such as your name, phone number, or other billing information, email address, and home or business postal addresses. We also collect information from you when you register for an event, fill out a form, or join an organization through the Website or Services.

Sensitive Information. From time to time, purchases made through the Website may require the provision of Sensitive Information, including Credit Card Numbers and/or Checking Account Numbers or other account numbers. Dunnpelliermedia.com and its owner, Dunn Pellier Media, INC considers all account numbers to be Sensitive Information. WE WILL SHARE THE SENSITIVE INFORMATION YOU PROVIDE WITH

OUR PAYMENT PROCESSING VENDOR. For your security, we encrypt the transmission of Sensitive Information using secure socket layer technology (SSL).

Log Data. When you use the Service, we automatically record information about your activity using the Services. This may include the your Internet Protocol (“IP”) address, browser type, the web page visited before you came to our website, information you search for on our website, locale preferences, identification numbers associated with your BrandonPugsley.com account, date and time stamps associated with transactions, system configuration information, metadata concerning your Files, and other interactions with the Service.

Cookies. We also use “cookies” to collect information and improve our Services. A cookie is a small data file that we transfer to your computer. We may use “persistent cookies” to save your registration ID and login password for future logins to the Service. We may use “session ID cookies” to enable certain features of the Service, to better understand how you interact with the Service and to monitor aggregate usage and web traffic routing on the Service. You can instruct your browser, by changing its options, to stop accepting cookies or to prompt you before accepting a cookie from the websites you visit. If you do not accept cookies, however, you may not be able to use all aspects of the Service.

How We Use Personal Information

Personal Information: In the course of using the Service, we may collect personal information that can be used to contact or identify you (“**Personal Information**”). Personal Information is or may be used: (i) to provide and improve our Service; (ii) to administer your use of the Service, (iii) to better understand your needs and interests; (iv) to personalize and improve your experience; (v) to provide or offer software updates and product announcements; (vi) to improve our website; (vii) to improve customer service; and/or (viii) to process transactions. You acknowledge that by providing your personal information, you authorize DunnPELLIERmedia.com to release such information to the entities related to DunnPELLIERMedia.com or Dunn Pellier Media, INC. Other than as described hereinabove, your information, whether public or private, will not be sold exchanged, transferred, or given to any other company for any reason whatsoever, without your consent, other than for the express purpose of delivering the DunnPELLIERmedia.com Service. If you no longer wish to receive communications from us, please follow the “unsubscribe” instructions provided in any DunnPELLIERMedia.com email, or update your profile information by sending a request to info@dunnPELLIERmedia.com.

Geo-Location Information: The Service may allow applications to access real-time location-based information (for example, GPS). As of the date this policy went into effect, DunnPELLIERmedia.com does not collect such information, but may do so in the future to improve our Services. We may use this information to optimize your experience. Also, some of the information we collect from your computer or other online

device, for example, IP address, can sometimes be used to approximate that device's location.

Analytics: We also collect some information (ourselves or using third party services) using logging and cookies, which can sometimes be correlated with Personal Information. We use this information for the purposes stated herein as well as to monitor and analyze use of the Service, for the Service's technical administration, to increase our Service's functionality and user-friendliness, and to verify users have the authorization needed for the Service to process their requests.

Please keep in mind that whenever you voluntarily make your personal information available for viewing by third parties online – for example on message boards, web logs, through email, or in chat areas – that information can be seen, collected and used by others besides us. We cannot be responsible for any unauthorized third-party use of such information.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

Your Use. The Website and Services provide interaction with other social media websites (such as Facebook and Twitter). Any information you choose to provide should reflect how much you want others to know about you. Please consider carefully what information you disclose through such social media websites.

Service Providers, Business Partners, and Others. We may use certain trusted third party companies and individuals to help us provide, analyze, and improve the Service (including but not limited to data storage, maintenance services, database management, web analytics, payment processing, and improvement of the Service's features). These third parties may have access to your information only for purposes of performing these tasks on our behalf and under obligations similar to those in this Privacy Policy. As of the date this policy went into effect, we use Go Daddy Web Services storage service to store some of your information. Third-Party Applications. We may share your information with a third party application with your consent, for example when you choose to access our Services through such an application. We are not responsible for what those parties do with your information, so you should make sure you trust the application and that it has a privacy policy acceptable to you.

Compliance with Laws and Law Enforcement Requests; Protection of DunnPellierMedia.com's Rights. We may disclose to parties outside of DunnPellierMedia.com, files stored in DunnPellierMedia.com and information about you that we collect when we have a good faith belief that disclosure is reasonably necessary to (a) comply with a law, regulation or compulsory legal request; (b) protect the safety of any person from death or serious bodily injury; (c) prevent fraud or abuse of

DunnPellicierMeida.com, or its users; (d) to protect DunnPellicierMedia.com's property rights; or (e) to avoid the infringement of the copyright, trademark, or other intellectual property rights of third parties. If we provide your DunnPellicierMedia.com files to a law enforcement agency as set forth above, we will remove DunnPellicierMedia.com's encryption from the files before providing them to law enforcement. However, DunnPellicierMedia.com will not be able to decrypt any files that you encrypted prior to storing them on DunnPellicierMedia.com.

Business Transfers. If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of our assets, your information may be transferred as part of that transaction, but we will notify you (for example, via email and/or a prominent notice on our website) of any change in control or use of your Personal Information or Files, or if either become subject to a different Privacy Policy. We will also notify you of choices you may have regarding the information.

Non-private or Non-Personal Information. We may disclose your non-private, aggregated, or otherwise non-personal information, such as usage statistics of our Service.

Third-Party Sites. Occasionally, at our discretion, we may include or offer third party products or services on our website. These third party sites have separate and independent privacy policies. We, therefore, have no responsibility or liability for the content and activities of these linked sites. Nonetheless, we seek to protect the integrity of our site and welcome any feedback about these sites.

Changing or Deleting Your Information

If you are a registered user, you may review, update, correct or delete the Personal Information provided in your registration or account profile by changing your "account settings." If your personally identifiable information changes, or if you no longer desire our service, you may update or delete it by making the change in your account settings. In some cases, we may retain copies of your information if required by law.

Data Retention

We will retain your information for as long as your account is active or as needed to provide you services. If you wish to cancel your account or request that we no longer use your information to provide you services, you may delete your account. We may retain and use your information as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements. Consistent with these requirements, we will try to delete your information quickly upon request. Please note, however, that there might be latency in deleting information from our servers and backed-up versions might exist after deletion. In addition, we do not delete from our servers files that you have in common with other users.

1. Does the website sell personal information?

No – we do not sell personal information.

1. Does the website keep my credit card information?

No – we do not store credit card information.

Security

The security of your information is important to us. When you enter Sensitive Information (such as a credit card number) on our order forms, we encrypt the transmission of that information using secure socket layer technology (SSL).

We follow generally accepted standards to protect the information submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it. No method of electronic transmission or storage is 100% secure, however. Therefore, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. Our Policy Toward Children

This children's privacy statement explains our practices with respect to the online collection and use of personal information from children under the age of thirteen, and provides important information regarding their rights under federal law with respect to such information.
